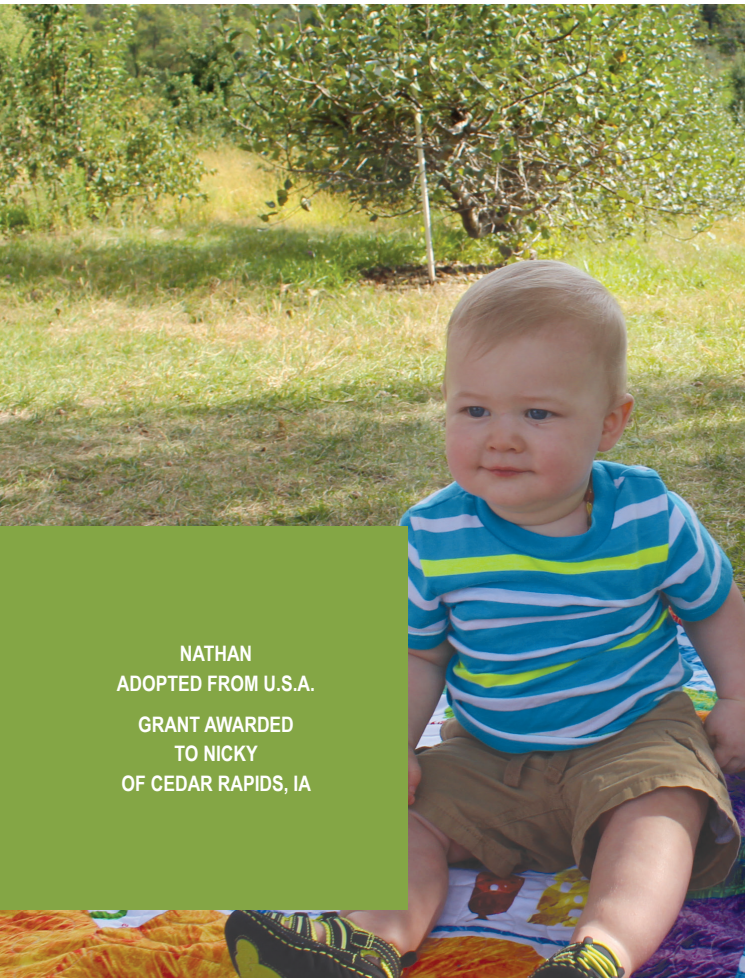

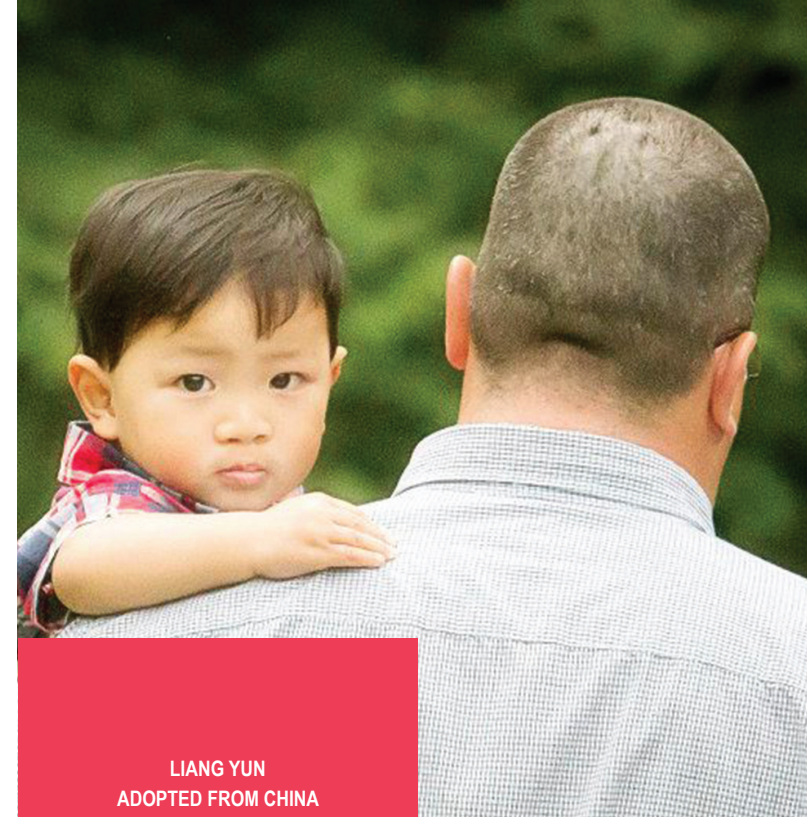

- There are over 153 million orphaned children worldwide, including 400,000 in the US
- The probability of being adopted is about 1.5%
- 25% of Americans have seriously considered adoption, yet only 1% complete the process, citing cost as a primary barrier

ADOPTION IS A LONG-TERM SOLUTION AND A WIN-WIN ON BOTH A HUMANITARIAN AND ECONOMIC LEVEL.

Helping a child get adopted significantly reduces the probability of hunger, homelessness, poverty, lack of education and dependence on government assistance which often result when a child is without a safe, permanent family.

- Children who might be placed in foster care unnecessarily

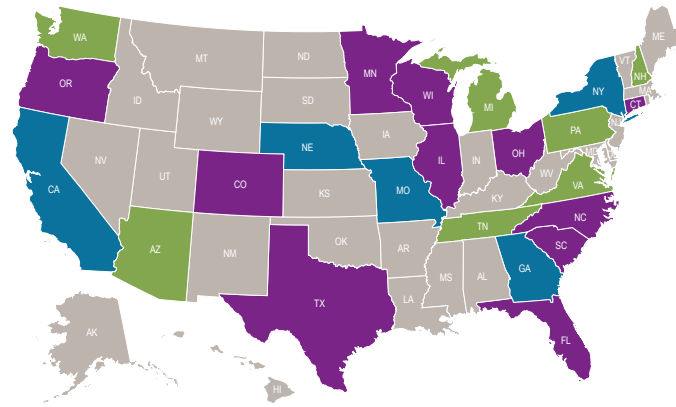
OUR VISION: TO MAKE ADOPTION FUNDING A NEW PHILANTHROPIC PRIORITY.
