

# Who We Serve: GOA Grant Families

GRANT RECIPIENTS ARE HARD-WORKING, DEDICATED PARENTS IN NEED OF THE LAST BIT OF FUNDING TO BRING AWAITING CHILDREN HOME.

- U.S. citizens with approved home studies from COA / Hague accredited agencies, adopting children from anywhere in the world.
- Demonstrated financial need, commitment to funding adoption through their own efforts, matched with a child.
- Priority is placed on awarding grants that keep siblings together (15%), prevent a child from entering (15%) or aging-out (13%) of the orphanage or foster care system, help children with life-threatening medical conditions get the urgent medical attention they need (36%).
