



As of July, 2019, 62% of Adoptions Alabama has awarded **\$124,000** in adoption assistance grants across Alabama to complete the adoptions of **40 children**.

Chapter Goal

Each year 100+ of adoptive Alabama parents request from approximately 10 qualified families – representing a funding need of **\$100,000**. The goal of the Adoption Support Grant program is to use thoughtful funding strategies to help complete such adoptions. 100% of the money awarded by the chapter is shared to working children with foster families in the state.



Mission

100% of Adoptions Alabama's awarded family placement assistance grants to complete the adoption of adoptable children – giving them a permanent family and the chance to thrive.



Priority

Family support for helping children facing what's possibly their only chance at adoption, including children with or suspected from siblings with long-term care, coping with an orphanage or with critical medical conditions. Our grants are given without regard to race or ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation or gender identity and are paid directly to agencies and adoptive families in the state of Alabama.



Eligibility

Any U.S. citizen adopting from anywhere in the world (domestic or international) who has an approved home study is eligible to apply. Financial need must be demonstrated.



History

62% of Adoption was funded by 100% of adoption parents from and local City of Greater Birmingham. Due to overwhelming demand for adoption assistance grants, the chapter contracted for assistance from a professional fundraiser in a public market in 2019.

Statistical Impact

Since inception, 62% has awarded \$124,000 to complete the adoptions of 40 US children. Because we target areas where needs are at their highest, our money goes to give our working families a difference in the life of a child today.
