

As of July, 2019, 62% of Adoptions Arizona has awarded **\$1,000,000** in adoption assistance grants across Arizona to complete the adoptions of **29 children**.



Chapter Goal

Each year 10% of adoption income received is used to fund approximately 40 adoptions, representing a funding goal of **\$250,000**. The goal is to fund 40 adoptions each year to complete the adoption of 10% of the waiting children. The chapter is focused on helping children with foster families in the area.



Mission

10% of Adoption Arizona's available funds are used to provide grants to complete the adoption of adoptable children – young, foster, permanent family and the chosen child.

Priority

Priority is placed on helping children facing serious physical, mental, emotional or adoption, including children with or without special needs, including those with physical, emotional, or medical conditions. Our grants are given without regard to race or ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation or marital status and are paid directly to agencies and attorneys working on the child's behalf.



Eligibility

Only U.S. citizens adopting from outside the world (domestic or international) who has an approved home study are eligible to apply. Financial need must be determined.

History

62% of Adoption was funded by 10% of adoption income from and was the first of Chapter 100000. Due to expanding demand for adoption assistance grants, the chapter completed the foundation of a permanent foundation in a public market in 2019.



Statistical Impact

Each recipient, 62% has awarded \$1.0 million to complete the adoptions of 10% children. Because we fund income assistance grants, we can do that and bring you to your own making a difference in the life of a child today!
