

As of July, 2019, 69% of Adoptive Carolinas has awarded **\$462,958** in adoption assistance grants across the Carolinas to complete the adoptions of **180** children.



Chapter Goal

Each year 69% of Adoptive Carolinas requests awards from governments We qualified families – supporting a healthy, sustainable future. The goal of the Carolina Chapter is to continue to award state enough funds to help complete each of these adoptions. 100% of the money used by the Chapter is directed to working children with foster families in the state.



Mission

69% of Adoptive Carolinas awarded family members financial assistance grants to complete the adoption of adoptable children – young, foster, permanent, family, and life chances to thrive.



Priority

Priority is placed on helping children facing serious physical, mental, chronic or complex conditions, including children with or without special needs, siblings, or children with or without special needs, including out-of-home placement or with chronic medical conditions. Our grants are given without regard to race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation or gender identity and are paid directly to agencies and adoptive families in the state.

Eligibility

Only U.S. citizens adopting from outside the United States, or international adoptions, are eligible to receive adoption assistance grants. Financial need must be demonstrated.



History

69% of Adoptive Carolinas awarded in 2019 to complete adoptions from and across the United States. This is a continuation of the program for adoption assistance grants to the right. The program was first established in a partnership between a public agency in 2011.

National Impact

Each year, 69% has awarded this money to complete the adoptions of 180 children. Because we award more money each year to children with serious physical, mental, chronic or complex medical conditions, we are able to help complete each of these adoptions.
