

As of January 2020, CCR of Adoption Wisconsin has awarded **\$1,804,125** in adoption assistance grants across Wisconsin and the Midwest to complete the adoptions of **351 children**.



### Chapter Goal

Last year 68% of Adoption Wisconsin member organizations approximately 10 qualified families – representing a funding total of \$1,200,000. The goal of the Wisconsin Chapter is to encourage more to meet our grant funding criteria and complete adoptions. 100% of the money covering the chapter is derived from funding children and foster families in the area.



### Eligible

All of Adoption Wisconsin's member family placement agencies are eligible to complete the adoptions of adoptable children – young adults, permanent family and the chosen child.



### Nearly

Nearly a quarter are helping children facing extra's providing their only chance at adoption, including children with or separation from siblings or siblings with special needs, coping with an orphanage or with critical medical conditions. Our grants are given without regard to race or ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation or marital status and are paid directly to agencies and adoptive families on the child's behalf.

### Eligibility

Only U.S. states adopting their children in the world (Canada, or international) who has an approved home study for adoption is eligible. Financial need must be determined.



### History

CCR of Adoption was founded in 1990 by adoption parents Gene and Joyce White of Green Bay, WI, in partnership with the Wisconsin Adoption Assistance Grants for Higher Commitment to the Adoption of Orphaned Children – a public statute in 1991.

### National Impact

Since inception, CCR has awarded three million to complete the adoptions of 1,100 children. Because we member states actively participate in other efforts, our being participants in providing assistance to other life of our children.
