

As of December 2020, Gift of Adoption Fund awarded **\$129,000** in adoption assistance grants to complete the adoption of **45 children** into families in Utah.



Chapter Goal

Each year, Gift of Adoption Fund receives more than 100 applications for qualified families requesting adoption grants totaling over **\$2.5M**. The goal of this chapter's activities is to award grants to help complete each of these adoptions. 100% of the money goes to the foster to adoptive and biological birth parent families in Utah.



2020-2021 Gift of Adoption Fund awarded \$45,000 in adoption assistance grants to complete the adoption of 10 foster children, giving them a permanent family and forever home.



2020-2021 Funds a special savings plan for every child being placed in a family that includes an employer, allowing birth parents to contribute to the child's future education, savings, and living costs. The plan allows birth parents to save into a 529 plan, 529 college savings plan, 529 education savings plan, and a 529 college savings plan, and a 529 college savings plan.



2020-2021 From 5 other adoption grant agencies in the state, we took on 100% of the cost of the grant program, allowing us to help 100% of the children in need of a permanent family.



2020-2021 Gift of Adoption Fund received a 100% adoption grant from the state of Utah. This means that no matter how many adoptions we complete, we will never run out of money. The state of Utah has a 100% adoption grant program that is funded by the state of Utah.

NATIONAL IMPACT

Gift of Adoption Fund has awarded \$10 million to complete the adoption of 1,000 children. This is a significant impact on the lives of children and their families, and it is a testament to the power of adoption.
