Drew and Ginger felt called to get involved. As a couple, they are committed to living their faith and values. Giving back to help other families afford adoption made sense to them.

As Drew explained, "Joining the Investor Board was a logical first step for us. We were impressed by GOA's track record of success and wanted to be a part of strengthening the organization. We also wanted to learn more. We knew about our personal experience of adoption but felt GOA could educate us on the field as a whole. Anderson has been a true gift to our family. He has taught us so much and made us better parents. We want to give that gift to others and help more children, like Anderson, find their forever families."
