



## Referral Guidelines for Adoption Assistance Grants

### General Information

- Is at least one adoptive parent a U.S. citizen?
- Is the child/young adult matched with an adoptive parent(s)?
- Is the adoption expected to be finalized within the next six months (but not yet finalized)?

### Financial Need

- Are there adoption-related expenses that are not yet paid or will not be subsidized (and are the family's responsibility)?
- Do the unpaid/unsubsidized expenses present a financial burden for the adoptive parent(s)?

- Two most recent pay stubs (or proof of income/SSI benefits, etc.)
