Dear Friends,

Welcome to our FY2024 Annual Report.

“Go as far as you can see, and when you get there, you’ll see farther” is an adage woven into Gift of Adoption’s essence.

A completed adoption is the first measure of our mission impact - children moving from a place of uncertainty to a place of security. From there, we see farther – witnessing our mission impact through the stories our grant recipient families share as their children grow up. Stories that demonstrate what is possible when children have access to loved ones, opportunities, and resources they need to thrive at critical, formative times in their young lives.

We hear charming stories from families like how readily a child took to swimming or how after taste-testing ten cakes, they discover their favorite birthday cake flavor!

We hear sad, moving stories about children whose lives were cut short by illness, but for whom the joys of childhood and of being loved were made real by families who knew them, held them and who will forever cherish them.

And, we hear remarkable updates about children like Mathias, now 20, pictured on our cover. Amanda, Mathias’ mom, shared that when Mathias was younger and other kids would tease him or ask pointed questions about his missing legs, he would lift himself up deliberately and rotate upside down to start doing push-ups from a handstand position....in his chair! No longer did people see Mathias as the kid who could not do something, but rather, he was seen as the kid who could do something **they could not do!** Today, Mathias is recognized for his athletic success as a national basketball team champion and Paralympic hopeful in tennis. He regularly receives awards and accolades for being a sought-after mentor and coach to youth (able-bodied or in chairs), and he is often tapped by employers to work on problems that defy others. Using CAD to improve wheelchair design and tackling machine-shop problems are just a few examples of the impact Mathias is making and a hint of the accomplishments he has ahead of him.

Children living life to the fullest is what Gift of Adoption is all about and **what you are making possible** through your kind and generous support throughout the year.

Since inception in 1996, Gift of Adoption has completed the adoptions of 6200 children, and together, in 2024, 725 more children were given a permanent family and the chance to thrive.

While we are beyond grateful to serve so many children and families, we continually look to do more because around the world millions of children linger in institutions or on the streets and in any given year in the US, half of the children eligible for adoption out of foster care remain unadopted.

Present funding allows Gift of Adoption to award grants to 2 of 3 qualified families who apply. This is where the “Go as far as you can see, and when you get there, you’ll see farther” adage becomes a mantra. We are committed to going farther – seeing and addressing the needs of both the children who wait and the families who yearn to adopt them.

On behalf of the national board, chapter boards, staff team and the thousands of families we’ve yet to reach, we want to thank you for your belief in and commitment to Gift of Adoption. The sometimes charming, sad, moving, and remarkable update stories remind us that the gifts we give are deep, enduring and allow all of us to see farther.

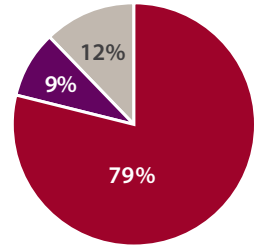

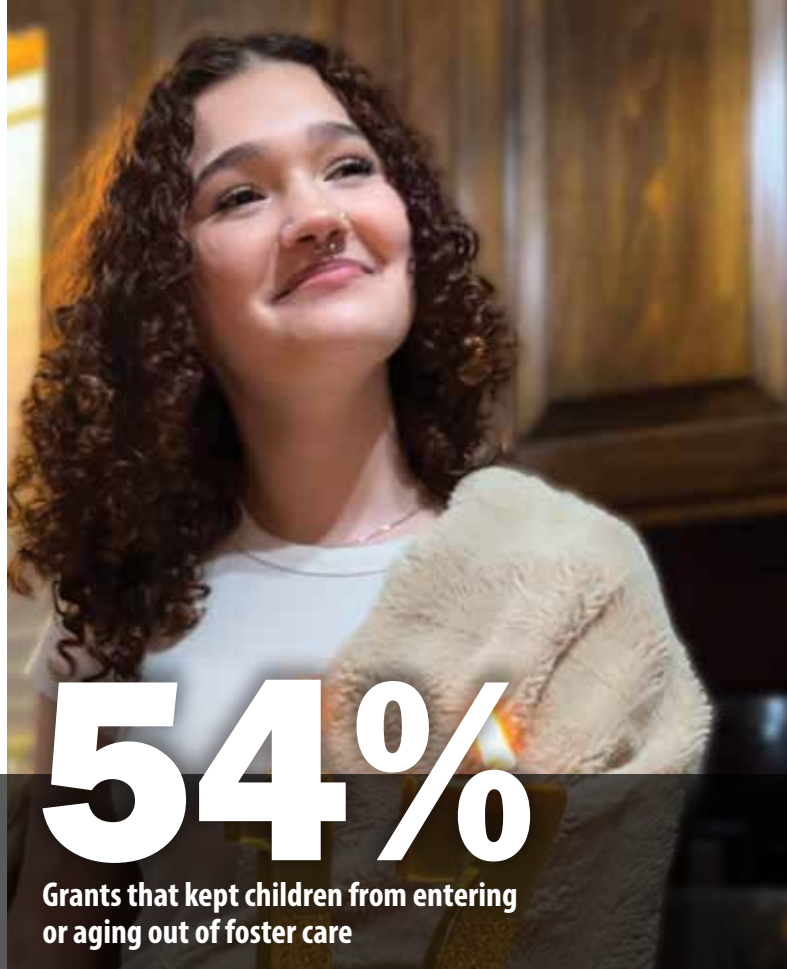

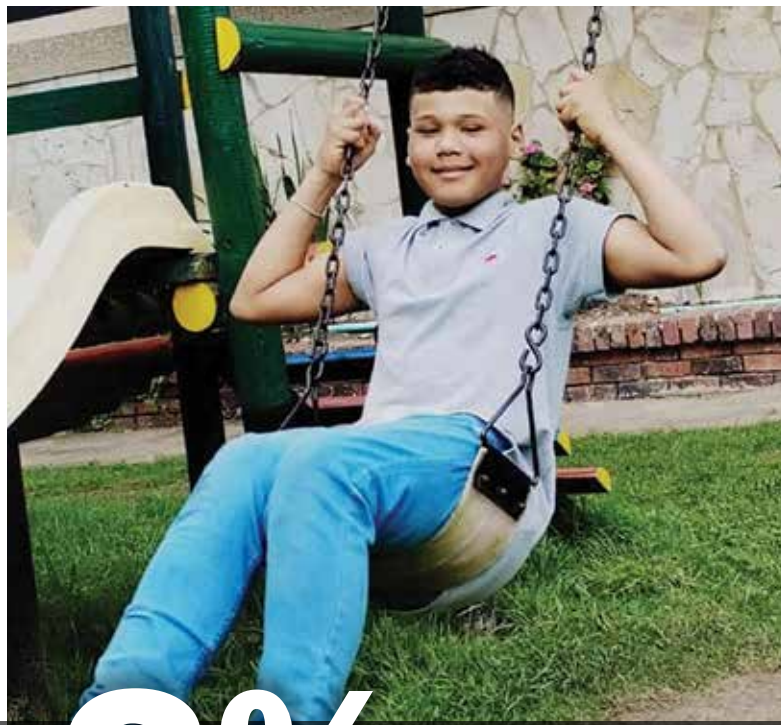
